There is a pattern of six steps over eight counts of music and the great thing about salsa is that just about anyone can learn it. The origin of the name "salsa" is a mystery. The dance was named after the style of music, but no one quite knows why it was named salsa. Some suggest the name comes from the food since it has elements from many cultures much like salsa has many ingredients. Others say it's because the dance's movements are hot and spicy, like salsa. No matter its origin, as a spectator, it is great fun to listen and watch!

Once again, Oceanside DJ, Dave Graham, will provide the music and there will be a few activities for kids.
