City of Parksville Licence Renewals for 2021

City of Parksville dog and business licence renewals are due January 31, 2021. Renewals are usually mailed to residents and businesses in early December; however, due to the current COVID-19 Public Health Officer orders, the City will mail licence renewals on January 4, 2021.

The recent PHO order requires that all individuals, places of work and businesses in the province significantly reduce their level of social interactions and travel. We have all been asked to stay home and limit our travel to essential only. We hope this change related to COVID-19 will provide one less errand or reason for our citizens to leave their homes over the next few weeks.

Should there be no additional provincial COVID-19 orders, dog licences can be paid in person at City Hall after January 4, 2021; no payments of dog licences will be accepted in December. Business licence renewals will also be mailed on January 4 and due January 31, 2021. The City expects to offer businesses the ability to pay licence renewals by credit card, in person at City Hall and online, as well as by mail or drop off. These arrangements will be confirmed in December and posted to our website.
