WHAT ARE DEVELOPMENT COST CHARGES ?

 Development Cost Charges (DCCs) are monies that are collected from land developers by a municipality, to offset some of the infrastructure expenditures incurred, to service the needs of new development.

A COMMON PHILOSOPHY

"The Developer must pay for the costs associated with development."

WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE ARE NO DCC'S?

The taxpayer will pay costs of the project needed to permit growth.



The needed work may not get done, so ...

The development may not be able to proceed.

IT'S A BALANCING ACT



HOW DO WE GET THE "RIGHT" BALANCE?

Variables that can change:

- Growth
 - Overall amount
 - Rate of growth
- Allocation of Developer amount
- Assist Factor
- Capital Project List overall & Individual Project costs
- Allocation of project to DCC's vs taxpayer

DCC'S =

• Net Capital Infrastructure Costs (- % Assist Factor) -/_

New Development Units

EXAMPLE:

 \$3 Million (-0% Assist Factor) '/ 6800 Expected = \$441.17 Sewage Treatment Facility New Units Unit

Example with 1% as Assist Factor:

 \$3 Million - 30,000 '/ 6800 Expected = \$436.76 New Units Unit

REVIEW PROCESS TO DATE

- May 2013 Council Adopts 2013-2017 Financial Plan including 20 Year Capital Plan.
- January 2013 May 2013 staff review current DCC program and makes appropriate changes to costs and projects and growth assumptions
